

**\$200 Million in Grants Available To Eligible Ohio Businesses**

Governor DeWine and Lt. Governor Husted announced that millions of dollars in grants remain available through the Ohio Development Services Agency for eligible Ohio businesses. These programs are intended to provide relief to certain industries that were negatively impacted by the effects of COVID-19. The table below contains a summary of these programs, outlines eligibility requirements, and provides other helpful information.
